THE CLUB

Formed in 1860, Thames Rowing Club is one of the country's oldest and most successful rowing clubs. Licensed for up to **400** people standing, **150** seated, **The Bar** and **The Great Hall** can be opened up for a variety of events, from small meetings and intimate dinner parties to weddings and conferences. Along with 6 metre high ceilings, The Great Hall also features large french doors which slide open to a large balcony, revealing unparalleled views to Putney Bridge and Hammersmith.

The Fairbairn Room is also perfect for more intimate events. Seating up to 28 people, this room is suitable for smaller meetings, or as a breakout space.

TRANSPORT

Foot:

We are one of the last Club Houses on the Embankment. A short walk from Putney High Street and close to all public transport.

Tube:

It is a short 10 minute walk from Putney Bridge Tube station over Putney Bridge to the venue.

Train:

Putney overland station is located on Putney High Street, the venue is a 15 minute walk down the High Street and along the Embankment. There are trains from Waterloo Station every 20 minutes.

Bus:

The closest bus stop to the venue is on Lower Richmond Road, where you can catch the 22 and 485. If you walk to Putney Bridge you can also take the 14, 22, 39, 74, 85, 93, 220, 270, 414, 424 and 430 services.

Boat:

Our partner Thames Clipper offer services from Central London to Putney Pier. Guests then have a short walk up to the venue.

Car:

The venue is a short drive from the A3. Take the A219 exit from Tibbet's Corner roundabout towards Putney, just before Putney Bridge turn left onto Lower Richmond Road (B306) and take the first right onto the Embankment. The venue is at the end of the Embankment. There is meter parking on the streets around the club, most times are from 10am-5pm, other restrictions may apply.

Bicycle:

Bicycle stands are located to the side of the Club House.
